

## Classroom Management System

My philosophy of classroom management is that I believe that every classroom should be a safe place for children where they feel comfortable to learn. I will create this environment by being very welcoming and making sure all of my students know that I'm there to keep them safe and they can tell me anything. I will make my classroom very inviting. I will have a reading corner with bean bags. The children can read there for good behavior. My classroom arrangement will be a big part of my classroom management also. I will try to set up desks in groups specific to needs of children. As talked about in my Education class ability grouping is a great way to respond to children's differences in abilities, so this will definitely be used in my classroom. I will put my desks in groups of four to make a table the children with the same learning needs will each sit at a table. I want my classroom to be a place where children want to come and where they can use creativity and imagination. My classroom will have all sorts of magical things. I will have a imagination station that has all sorts of art activities. Here the children can be creative while they are learning. The imagination station will be used in my curriculum and will be another place kids can go as a reward.

I want to have a curriculum that is challenging yet fun. I will make sure that every student is challenged in there own way yet try to incorporate fun in my curriculum. I will give students challenging tests and reward them with treasure tickets if they do well. These treasure tickets will go in the ticket box and at the end of every week I will pick 3 tickets. These 3 people will get to choose a prize from the treasure box. I want to also have a reward system for the children in my class for good behavior so they have an incentive to be there just besides learning. My reward system will be Behavior Bucks. Students will receive behavior bucks for behaving, answering questions correctly, being respectful and following rules. At the end of every month we will have a Class Store where children can buy items that I have brought with their money they have earned. I know my students won't always behave so I will try to discuss their behavior problems with them one on one as to not embarrass them in front of their peers. I will first take them in the hall and talk to them about what they think they could be doing differently in class and what caused them to be pulled out of class, this will be their warning. If the problem continues I will have time cards that require students to stay inside and give me time during their recess. The first card will be yellow which was their warning card. The next card they get will be red and will mean 5 minutes of recess. My Rules Chart and Chore Chart will also be an other important part of my classroom management. They will help keep the children safe and teach them responsibility and respect. My rules chart will include basic classroom rules such as no running, raise your hand, don't interrupt, respect others and be kind. The chore chart will be small duties around them classroom and each student will have their own job. These jobs will consist of picking up scraps, garbage duty, desk cleaning duty and board duty. There will be four or five students assigned to each job and will rotate bi-weekly.

I will encourage all of the children in my classroom to participate and help them to believe that they are important. I will do this by taking turns calling on each student for different questions and giving them praise for answering the question. I will point out students positive attributes to them to show them their importance. I want to get to know all of my students and be a positive role model in there life that they will always remember. I will accomplish this by being interested in their hobbies and lives. I will always try to be the best at what I do. I will be kind and respectful and teach my students why doing these things is important. I will treat others as I would want to be treated and my students will learn from this. The way I manage my classroom will have a lot to do with my teaching. I want my class to enjoy school and believe that I'm a great teacher. I believe that all these things that I have mentioned will help me do that.
